Enhanced capabilities of QSP include the ability to manipulate scanned images before insertion into BDMS and the ability to index documents during the scan process by manually entering index field data or automatically via index field data OCR'd directly from the documents themselves. This will be followed by a demonstration product/update information. Also hear about our improved CO-OP with over 500 pre delivered of the basic setup for scanning batches and single documents and auto-indexing using zonal OCR.
